OUR MISSION

Curado is a provider of residential care and supported living services which promotes independent living & social inclusion in the community.

Passionate about delivering quality, recovery-oriented care, we have a values-based approach and work closely with our clients, their families, statutory and voluntary organisations and health and social care professionals.





THE NEED FOR OUR WORK

1 in 4 adults & 1 in 10 children experience a mental illness in the UK.

The Impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on people living with severe mental illnesses has increased the demand on NHS mental health services.

Aftercare services are also more in demand as they reduce the risk of a mental health condition getting worse and having to go back to hospital.

OUR IMPACT ON OUR CLIENTS

80% of our service-users have moved along their care pathways to more independent accommodation settings within 18 – 24 months.

They've also completed further education courses, undertaken vocational training and gained meaningful employment, such as baristas, plumbers & electricians.

These positive outcomes have been evidenced by Care Quality Commission inspection ratings, feedback from professionals, residents and their families.


A rating of Good and Outstanding was obtained in the last Care Quality Commission inspection where Outstanding was awarded for being well led.



OUR IMPACT ON THE NHS

As NHS Trusts struggle to manage demand within ever tightening resources, the risks associated with this are early and delayed discharges and failure to adequately engage patients in the community.

Curado has provided the expertise to translate the care needs of patients into robust and effective care plans to support recovery, self-reliance and improve physical health. Our referrals and service provision have subsequently increased over time from being primarily male to catering for both genders. After having the first female client in 2023, our female resident population has increased from 5% to 17% in 2024

Curado is an established I Care Ambassador Service which is a Department of Health & Social Care initiative which aims to facilitate the uptake of mental health & social care positions in the UK especially amongst young people by inspiring them through a series of role plays & interactive sessions based on real life situations in Curado.

A range of activities have been delivered by Curado including talks at schools, colleges and universities & participation in careers fairs. As such Curado has engaged with over 500 students and provided work experience and internship opportunities.
